

PITTSFIELD TOWN SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY

Title: **Tuition Policy**

It is the policy of the Pittsfield School Board (PSB) to provide tuition as required by Vermont law for all students who are legal residents of Pittsfield. See 16 V.S.A. §§11, 821-828, 1073, 1075. Residents who wish to obtain tuition payments from the PSB for their children are required to file an application developed by the PSB and made widely available to all Pittsfield residents.

The PSB will not authorize tuition payment for any Pittsfield student without sufficient information provided in the application to support such funding. Changes of a student's legal residence must be reported to the PSB immediately.

The PSB is authorized to seek remedies against legal guardians who falsify or otherwise prevent the PSB from obtaining accurate information about a supposed legal student's status as eligible for tuition payment by the PSB. The PSB is authorized to seek repayment of any funds spent on tuition not authorized by statute based on inaccurate or insufficient information.
